

How to wire money internationally between banks

Make sure to verify all the details of your wire transfer with your bank before you begin. Check with your service provider for limits.

Remember that some banks may require you to be a customer for a certain amount of time before you can make a wire transfer. The bank may have a form you need to fill out, or you might be able to start the process online.

To send funds using a traditional bank wire, you'll need the following:

- Recipient bank name (the bank that the money is going to)
- Recipient bank's branch code
- Bank account number at the bank
- Swift Code

Contact your bank after you submit your request to confirm they have everything they need.

You should expect to pay a fee for the service. Wire transfers can cost as much as \$45 for international transfers.

If you use a credit card, your card issuer may charge these additional fees, since they treat the wire transfer like a cash advance.¹
